Academic 7 / Peterson Family Health Sciences Hall (under construction)

- College of Health and Human Services academic departments and research centers relocate to this new building
- Growth research space included in bldg. program (assignment/use TBD)
- Estimated Construction Completion Fall 2017

• **Estimated Move-in** – Within the Fall 2017 semester; first classes meet in university classrooms and CHHS assigned class labs Spring 2018

Potomac Science Center (under construction)


- Located at Belmont Bay
- College of Science research labs/support
- K-12 outreach program space included in bldg. program
- Estimated Construction Completion Spring 2017

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M.I.X. in Fenwick A-Wing (design completed; awaiting funding)


- · Construction documents completed and submitted for permit review
- AVP for Entrepreneurship/Innovation meeting with prospective donors
- · Project ready to go out for bid and construction as soon as full funding is available



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Johnson Center Phase II Dining Project (final design review phase)

- Project includes renovations to current food court area of Johnson Center 1st floor and infrastructure updates to support new private tenant in former Jorge's location
- Target Start February 2017
- Target Completion August 2017

Robinson Hall / Utility Infrastructure Project (future capital project)

- Awaiting Final Notice of Funding Availability from State
- Schedule for Robinson, Harris and Related Utility Infrastructure
 - Estimated Design Completion Summer 2018
 - Estimated Construction Phase I Begins Summer 2018
 - Estimated Phase I Construction Complete Fall 2020
 - Estimated Phase II Construction Complete Summer 2022

Schedule for Remaining Utility Infrastructure Scope of Work

- Phasing and schedule TBD to coordinate with Robinson project work
- Estimated Completion Date for all utility work 2020

Bull Run Hall Addition Project (future capital project)

- Initial Building Space Program Interviews/Discussions with Units Early October 2016
 - Define/confirm vision for Science & Technology Campus
 - Define/confirm priorities for academic programs/research to be located at the campus
 - Define program priorities for addition
- A/E Selected for Programming Phase (Perkins/Eastman)
- Solicitation for A/E to begin design phase contingent upon funding decisions with Robinson project


Plan Submitted to State September 2, 2016

REVIEW OF NEW PROPOSED LOCATION FOR FACULTY/STAFF CLUB

Hampton Roads – Pilot House Dining Venue – Reassign for Use as Faculty/Staff Club

- Minor updates to existing Pilot House space to convert for Faculty/Staff Club (food and beverage) to promote crossdisciplinary collaboration among faculty from varying academic units
- Previous location reviewed (JC George's) determined not to be ideal due to frequency of use to support university-wide event space needs
- Proposed timeline for opening of Club at Pilot House late January 2017
- Faculty/Staff Club operational during fall and spring semesters space will be available to reserve for university events needs when Club not open and during summer semester



Hampton Roads – 1st Floor

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SPACE REQUESTS IN PLANNING FOR REVIEW

CHSS – Center for Climate Change Communication (4C)

- Request additional office space for new staff being hired in support of newly awarded grant project
- Worked with CHSS to locate interim solution in space assigned to CHSS longer term solution for colocation of the new staff with other 4C staff now located in Research Hall in development

• Provost – Office of Digital Learning and Center for Teaching/Faculty Excellence Colocation Plan

- Request space to co-locate staff from these two offices together to facilitate collaboration to meet
 strategic goals for faculty support/development and on-line instructional strategies
- Proposed location selected location will involve multiple relocations in order to free up space needed for this co-location request
- Units involved in proposed relocation plan have reviewed/approved options available for various space reassignments details to be presented for review at next SAC meeting

COS – Forensic Science Mock Crime Scene House

- Received request from COS/Forensic Science Program to assist with determining space options/locations for a proposed mock crime scene house
- Mock crime scene house is needed to support lab/experiential learning component of the program to allow students to work in a "real world" scenario location to be trained on techniques for evidence collection/processing
- Planning will begin work to identify potential options to meet this need once review with Dean and Provost is completed

School of Business – Additional Faculty Offices

- Received request for (16) new faculty office spaces in Enterprise Hall to accommodate growth needs
- Number of offices requested is not available in Enterprise Hall and limited options available in other locations
- Will work with S-Business space liaison to review options for reassignments of existing space assigned to the unit that may help meet some of these needs
- Determine options once final number of spaces that is needed to meet office shortfall is available
