



ASBESTOS STATEMENT

Building Code Services

When buildings that were built before 1985 are renovated or demolished, Section 110.3 of the Virginia Uniform Statewide Building Code requires that they be inspected for the presence of asbestos and that appropriate response be taken. In order to verify compliance with these requirements, please complete this form and submit it with the building permit application prior to the start of work.

- The building is exempt from this regulation because:
 - the structure was built after 01 January 1985.
 - the combined amount of asbestos-containing material involved in the renovation or demolition is:
 - less than 260 linear feet on pipes.
 - less than 160 square feet on other components (wall, floor, ceiling, duct, etc).
 - less than 35 cubic feet when removed from facility components where length or area could not be measured prior to removal.
- The materials to be removed or replaced are assumed to contain asbestos and the appropriate actions will be taken. *
- The affected area of the building was inspected by personnel licensed in the Commonwealth of Virginia to identify the presence of asbestos and that:
 - no asbestos was detected.
 - asbestos was detected and response actions to abate any risk to human health have been taken. *
 - asbestos was detected and response action to abate any risk to human health will be undertaken as part of the renovation or demolition project. *
